Pursuant to the orders of this Court dated 15.09.2017 and 13.10.2017, a report of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate (NRI Court), Jalandhar has been received, dated 22.11.2017, stating to the effect that in the file titled as State vs. Subhash Chander pertaining to FIR no.155 dated 18.06.2012 registered at Police Station Nakodar, (wherein as per learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is also an accused), there is no order showing the petitioner to have been ever declared a proclaimed offender.

In the aforesaid circumstances, naturally, there being no order of declaring the petitioner to be a proclaimed offender, this petition is obviously rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such. All legal remedies as are available to the petitioner, qua the FIR registered against him, would be open to him to take.
