In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 of Cr.P.C in case FIR No.58 dated 19.06.2018 registered under Section 61/1/14 of Punjab Excise Act at Police Station Sadar Sangrur District Sangrur.

2. Petitioners were granted the benefit of interim bail vide order dated 13.08.2018 and directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kulwinder Singh submitted that pursuant to the order dated 13.08.2018 petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

4. Accordingly, order dated 13.08.2018 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

5. Petition stands allowed accordingly.
