The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 89 dated 19.05.2018, under Sections 336, 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Lambi, District Muktsar Sahib.

The operative part of the order dated 23.07.2018, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“As per averments taken in the present petition, co-accused of the petitioner namely Kulwinder Singh has been granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 09.07.2018 passed in CRM-M-27697-2018 and as per the FIR, the allegations against the petitioner are identical to aforesaid co-accused Kulwinder Singh.

Notice of motion for 08.10.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 23.07.2018, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Vipan

Kumar, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 23.07.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
