Though learned counsel for the petitioner has argued in detail with regard to the statement of the complainant side having been altered to the effect that the deceased Munish Singh @ Mannu was kidnapped and thereafter a poisonous substance was administered to him by the petitioner and his co-accused, without making any comment on the correctness of that supplementary statement or otherwise, whether the death was caused by an organophosphorus compound or due to the deceased having been attacked with a base ball bat by the petitioner (as alleged against him in the FIR), or due to any other reason, at present the allegations being strongly against the petitioner for causing the death of the deceased, I see no reason to grant him bail at this stage even though he is stated to have undergone almost one year of imprisonment, with the trial still not having progressed much beyond one witness.

observation of this Court on the merits of the case for or against the petitioner, which naturally would be looked at by the trial Court wholly on the basis of evidence led before it, with the observation made hereinabove to be taken only in the context of the application seeking bail for him.

Dismissed.
