The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.580 dated 21.11.2017 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar under Sections 323, 325, 341, 294, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 308 IPC was added later on.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties have now reached an amicable settlement and a quashing petition vis. **Crl. Misc. No. M-22832 of 2018** is pending in this Court. Moreover, no specific role is attributed to the petitioner. The investigation is complete but the trial may take some time to conclude and, therefore, the petitioner be released on regular bail.

Learned State counsel does not dispute that the challan has already been presented.

Keeping in view the aforementioned circumstances, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
