Learned counsel for the petitioner points to the fact that all other co-accused of the petitioner, i.e. Gursewak Singh, Garhgajjit Singh, Mandeep Singh and Bachittar Singh, have been granted the concession of bail by this Court vide orders passed in different petitions, copies of which have been annexed as Annexure P-1 (collectively).

He further submits that one Manjit Singh was even granted anticipatory bail vide the order dated 09.10.2017 passed in CRM-M-31989-2017.

He further points to the FIR to submit that the petitioners' role is no different from that of Gursewak Singh, Garhgajjit Singh, Mandeep Singh and Bachittar Singh, which learned State counsel could not factually deny though she otherwise opposes granting of bail to him.

That being so, this petition is allowed, with the petitioner also having been in custody for the last more than one year with no witness still having been examined before the trial Court.

Consequently, upon the petitioner furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court, he would be admitted to bail, during the pendency of the trial.
