ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 161 dated 02.05.2018, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B of the IPC at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties, vide affidavit 07.07.2018 of the complainant (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the complainant also admits to the factum of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Karanjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the facts that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 26.05.2018; the matter has been compromised between the parties and also in view of the fact that conclusion of the the trial is likely to take some time; the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
