Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 7 to protect the life and property of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 15.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the aforesaid relief, the petitioner has already made a representation dated 28.06.2018 (Annexure P-10) to respondent No.2 Director General of Police, Punjab and at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.3 Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Jagraon, District Ludhiana is directed to consider the aforesaid representation.

Heard.

The petitioner has projected her case on the basis of revenue record. Concededly, civil litigation is also pending between the parties. Thus, without observing anything on the merits of the case lest it may prejudice the interest of the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Jagraon, District Ludhiana to look into the contents of representation dated 28.06.2018 (Annexure P-10) and to act in accordance with law.
