The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.197 dated 20.8.2014 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 22 NDPS Act at Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.

Heard.

The present case falls within the category of commercial quantity. No ground is made out for grant of regular bail, yet the petitioner is seeking bail on humanitarian ground with regard to illness of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel while filing reply agrees with the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner with regard to illness of the petitioner which transpires that the medicines as prescribed by the doctor are provided to the petitioner.

Dismissed.

However, the learned trial court is directed to conclude the trial

within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

The Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran is directed to produce the entire witnesses on 22.1.2018 before the learned trial Court, failing which, he shall personally appear before this Court and submit his explanation in this regard.
