MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

The petitioner has brought this petition for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 for taking appropriate action in respect of false and frivolous complaints, being filed at the behest of respondent Nos.6 to 8 despite the compromise being entered between the petitioner and respondent No.5, namely, Gurdev Singh.

It is pleaded in the petition that on account of certain financial dealings with the family of the petitioner and respondent Nos.5 to 7, a compromise was entered into between the parties and as per that a sum of ₹1,20,000/- was to be paid by Rakesh Kumar to Gurdev Singh. Despite the compromise and the settlement of the issues, frivolous applications/complaints are being filed.

The petition has been preferred by Ajay Pal Singh who happens to be the uncle of Rakesh Kumar, who had the monetary issues with the private respondents. There is no complaint appended with the petition which

would indicate that the respondents have filed any complaint against Rakesh Kumar or the petitioner/Ajay Pal Singh, as alleged.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to issue any kind of direction to official respondents.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
