In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for the following relief:

“Petition under Section 482 Cr.PC. For issuance of directions to Respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as respondents No.5 to 7 are falsely impleading the petitioner in false complaints in order to grab the land and house of the petitioner at his native place.

Further for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation and to restrain the respondent No.5 to 7 from harassing the petitioner and for providing his police protection.”

2. Perusal of the reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dabwali filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4, it is evident that they have assured the petitioners to approach them as and when there is a threat.

3. Having regard to these facts and circumstances, present petition do not survive for consideration.

4. Accordingly, petition stands disposed of. Reserving liberty to

the petitioners to approach concerned police authority for necessary protection in view of the statement made in reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dabwali filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.
