KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has filed the present petition for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.74, dated 03.04.2018, under Sections 307, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City South, Moga.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh, has informed the Court that injury under Section 307 IPC attributed by the co-accused is on the head. This Court has been further informed this Court that the case is fixed for framing of charges and evidence of the injured and complainant is yet to be recorded. Therefore, at this stage, if the petitioner is released on bail, he may try to influence the witnesses.

In these circumstances, at this stage, there is no ground to grant concession of bail to the petitioner. However, after the examination of the complainant and the injured, he shall be entitled to file fresh bail petition.

As such, the present petition is disposed of.
