The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.159 dated 18.3.2018, under Sections 406, 420-B IPC, Police Station Sector 31, Faridabad.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Smt. Saroj who alleged that she had given her Santro car bearing registration No. DL-2CW-2760 to the petitioner for his personal use in the month of July, 2016 but the petitioner thereafter neither returned back the car nor furnished any information regarding the same.

Notice of motion was issued to the respondent.

It has been informed by learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Sumer Singh that the police, consequent upon investigation had found the petitioner innocent and is filing "untraced report". It has also been informed that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

In view of the aforesaid position there is no ground for any custodial interrogation. In my opinion it is a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail. The petition is as such accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 23.7.2018 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when directed and would fully cooperate with the investigation.
