Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.1029 dated 15.09.2016 under Sections 406, 420 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Gurgaon, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 11.09.2018 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar, does not dispute the aforesaid fact. However, he submits that

except the question 'as to who used to change the email of the purchase order of the buying house?' the petitioner has answered all the questions.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

It is the pleaded case of the petitioner that he is an employee of M/s Silverstar Fashions Private Limited and has been acting as per the instructions of Ravi Dhingra and Bharat Makkar, the then directors of the company. Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custody is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 11.09.2018 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
