This is a petition filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.306 dated 24.07.2017, under Sections 307, 427, 34 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 21, 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act registered at Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh.

Learned State counsel conceded that recovery effected from the petitioner is non-commercial quantity but she had violated the terms of bail bonds.

Petitioner was earlier on bail but she found absent on 18.05.2018, therefore, her bail was cancelled and bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited to the State and she was summoned through non-bailable warrants.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial court within ten days. On

doing so, she shall be released on anticipatory bail subject to its satisfaction.

Petition is allowed accordingly.
