The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0051 dated 20.06.2018, registered under Sections 420 IPC at Police Station Bahavwala, District Fazilka.

It is the allegation against the petitioner that he received Rs.3,50,000/- from the complainant on the pretext of getting him employment in Nagar Council as petitioner was an ex-Sarpanch of the village. Neither he got the job to the complainant nor he returned the money.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the complaint has been moved at a highly belated stage and prayed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Heard.

To the mind of this Court, serious allegations have been

levelled agianst the petitioner. As such, no ground is made out to extend the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. However, the fact regarding delay will be considered by the trial court.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed.
