FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Sukhbir Singh in case registered by way of FIR No.11 dated 17.05.2018 at Police Station Women Cell, Patiala under Sections 406, 498-A IPC.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Mander Singh, Police Station Women Cell, Patiala submits that in compliance of the orders of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigations and recovery has been effected. Though the same is sought to be opposed by Mr. Gurinder Sidhu, Advocate representing the complainant on the grounds that the articles so recovered are not the articles of Istri Dhan. This being a question to be adjudicated at the trial, cannot be resolved at this juncture.

In view thereof and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 08.08.2018 is made absolute, however, he shall continue to abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. Thereafter, the petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
