Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0136 dated 25.04.2018 under Sections 379-B, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, Tehsil Dera Bassi, District-SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that apart from the fact that the complainant-Sanjay has furnished an affidavit that he has never disclosed the name of the petitioner to the police, petitioner is in custody since 30.04.2018, and there is no other case against him. Trial in the case will take long time

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that the co-accused Sunny Bawa @ Bawa has already been admitted on regular bail by this Court vide order dated 25.07.2018 passed in CRM-M-30313-2018 in

case Sunny Bawa @ Bawa Vs. State of Punjab and Anr. The case of the petitioner is covered with the said order.

Learned State counsel files custody certificate in Court today and the same is placed on record. As per custody certificate no other case is pending against the him.

Since the co-accused has been granted regular bail by this Court and the allegations levelled against the petitioner are similar to the allegations levelled against the other accused, petitioner deserves to be released on bail.

In view of the above, present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bond/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner is found indulged in any other case of similar nature, the prosecution shall be at liberty to seek cancellation of his bail.
