The petitioners Harjinder Singh and Sanjay Kumar @ Laddi seek grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered against them vide FIR No.250 dated 30.5.2017 under Sections 379-A and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Ambala City, District Amabla.

The FIR, in the present case, was lodged on 30.5.2017 at the instance of Prabhat Kumar Gupta, wherein he alleged that his son Hitesh Gupta was having a mobile phone purchased through 'Flipkart' for an amount of ₹ 10,999/- and that on 20.5.2017 two persons came on a motorcycle and snatched the said mobile phone from his son. Though the FIR in question was registered in May 2017, it was much later that the petitioners were arrested on the basis of CCTV footage collected from some shop in the area.

The learned State counsel has informed that the mobile phone in question has been recovered from the petitioners and that the challan is almost ready for its presentation. The learned State counsel has further

informed that the petitioners are behind bars since the last about one month.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, in my opinion, no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioners behind bars any further.

In view of abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is allowed. The petitioners Harjinder Singh and Sanjay Kumar @ Laddi are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned subject to the condition that petitioners Harjinder Singh and Sanjay Kumar @ Laddi will not indulge in any activity akin to one for which they have been convicted. In case of any such eventuality the prosecution agency will be at liberty to seek the cancellation of the order granting bail to the petitioners.
