The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Ankit in case FIR No.529 dated 17.06.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302, 397 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, "IPC") and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station City Ballabgarh.

Learned State counsel submitted that case is fixed for arguments. However, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he wants to lead defence evidence.

No case is made out to grant bail.

Petition stands dismissed accordingly.

However, learned trial court is directed to dispose of the matter as early as possible preferably, within a period of sixty days, by giving short adjournments on day-to-day basis.
