The petitioner prays for issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect his life and liberty as the same is being allegedly threatened by respondents No. 5 and 6.

The petitioner is the brother of one Balvir Singh, who was late father of respondent No. 5 and husband of respondent No. 6. He was allegedly murdered by respondent No. 5 because said Balvir Singh had transferred his property in the name of his grand son, as respondent No. 5 is allegedly drug addict. Respondent No. 6 got an FIR registered against respondent No. 5, in which name of the deceased is mentioned as Gurdev Singh instead of Balvir Singh. The allegation is that the petitioner is Gurdev Singh and by mentioning that he had been murdered by respondent No. 5, respondents No. 5 and 6 are trying to usurp his property. A representation dated 22.11.2017 (Annexure P-3) has been submitted in this regard but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4 only.

Mr. J.S. Walia, Sr. DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4.

The petitioner is directed to supply five copies of the petition to the learned State counsel within 24 hours.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notices to respondents No. 5 and 6.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 3 to objectively consider the representation dated 22.11.2017 (Annexure P-3) and in case it is found that the allegations of the petitioners are true, appropriate action be taken thereupon in accordance with law.
