The petitioner prays for issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to take appropriate action against the private respondents on the basis of representation dated 13.11.2017 (Annexure P-1). The petitioner alleges that the private respondents have illegally confined him and assaulted him and also deprived him of gold rings and some cash. This was done because he went to help the girl namely Poonam. She allegedly told the petitioner that she was being sexually harassed by the private respondents. A detailed representation dated 13.11.2017 (Annexure P-1) has been submitted to the Director General of Police, Haryana but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4 only.

Mr. S.P. Singh, AAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4.

The petitioner is directed to supply five copies of the petition to the learned State counsel within 24 hours.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notices to respondents No. 5 to 8.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 3

to objectively consider the representation dated 13.11.2017 (Annexure P-1) and to take action in accordance with law in case the allegations are found to be true. The needful be done within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

The petitioner is directed to supply copy of the aforementioned representation to respondent No. 2 alongwith copy of this petition.
