1. In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner, prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and proceed against the private respondents, who embezzled amount of Rs.246.82 lakh of Panchayat Fund illegally.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, if respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, is directed to decide representation dated 18.06.2018 (Annexure P-2), moved by the petitioner.
