Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and property of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of private respondent No.4, who has committed fraud upon the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner states that respondent No.4 entered into an agreement to sell dated 20.08.2015 for purchase of land and as against the total sale consideration of Rs.10.20 lakh, the petitioner has paid Rs.8 lakh. Her husband is an Army person and at present, he is posted in Jammu & Kashmir. He further states that the Patwari Halqa had submitted a report dated 27.11.2015, wherein the land mentioned in Khasra No.2221/443 (22-8) does not exist in the village and there is no land in the name of respondent No.4 under these Khasra numbers.

He further contends that for the threat extended by the petitioner, she has submitted a representation dated 12.06.2018 (Annexure P-7) to respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur. He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.3 to consider the said representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Tanvir Joshi, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to look into the contents of representation dated 12.06.2018 (Annexure P-7) and to act in accordance with law.
