Prayer in this second petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.156 dated 02.12.2017 registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and 25, 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Phool, District Bathinda.

The first petition filed by the petitioner i.e. CRM-M No.3856 of 2018 along with CRM-M No.3528 of 2018 filed by the co-accused namely Ranjit Singh @ Raja, by passing a detailed order, was dismissed on 08.02.2018.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the police while submitting the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has found the petitioner innocent and kept him in Column No.2 and therefore, he is filing the second petition for grant of anticipatory bail.

Counsel for the State has not disputed the fact that during the investigation, the petitioner was found innocent and he was kept in Column No.2 in the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case and in view of the fact that the police has not submitted the challan against the petitioner, this petition is dismissed.
