The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.252 dated 10.05.2018, registered under Sections 323, 34, 341, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Civil Lines Hisar, District Hisar.

It has been alleged that on 09.05.2018, complainant went to apprehend the petitioner-Pardeep Aggarwal who was roaming in the court premises. He has caused simple hurt.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 24.07.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
