The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.28 dated 3.4.2010 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 326, 323, 427, 506 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sadar, SBS Nagar, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

Heard.

Learned State counsel submits that in fact the petitioner has violated the terms of the bail bonds and, therefore, non-bailable warrants of arrest against the petitioner have been issued.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has noted the wrong date and therefore, could not appear before the court below on the date fixed.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to surrender before the

learned appellate court within seven days and on his doing so, he be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the learned appellate court.
