Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0136 dated 25.04.2018 under Sections 379-B, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, Tehsil Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that apart from the fact that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner, the other co-accused, namely, Ranbir Singh @ Rana (in CRM-M-30823-2018 titled as Ranbir Singh @ Rana Versus State of Punjab, decided on 27.07.2018) and Sunny Bawa @ Bawa (in CRM-M-30313-2018 titled as Sunny Bawa @ Bawa Versus State of Punjab and another, decided on 25.07.2018) have been admitted on regular bail by this Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Paramjit Kaur, does not dispute that the other co-accused, namely, Ranbir Singh @ Rana

and Sunny Bawa @ Bawa have been admitted on bail by this Court. He states that in this case recovery of Rs.11,000/- and mobile phone was effected from the possession of Raman Verma @ Chucha.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the co-accused have been admitted on bail by this Court, petitioner is in custody since 25.04.2018 and the trial in the case will take long time, this Court finds that the petitioner deserves to be admitted on bail.

In view of above, present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner is found indulged in any other case of similar nature, the prosecution shall be at liberty to seek cancellation of his bail.
