The petitioner prays for direction to respondents to investigate the complaint submitted by her.

Her grievance is that her mother and brother have produced some woman and have mis-represented to the revenue authority that she was the petitioner. The said lady has signed as the petitioner and has accepted that the father of the petitioner had in fact, executed a Will dated 24.02.1998. It is also her grievance that her mother and brother have mis-appropriated cheques issued by the Life Insurance Corporation in her favour, although later on, money transferred through the said cheques, had been returned. A complaint dated 28.05.2018 (Annexure P3) has been submitted in this regard, but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. J.S. Walia, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Let three copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to ask for a reply, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to look into the allegations made in the representation (Annexure P3) only so far as the Will dated 24.02.1998, is concerned. In case

the enquiry reveals that some action needs to be taken upon the allegations made in the said representation, appropriate action be taken in accordance with law. The needful be done within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
