The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.58 dated 23.04.2016, registered at Police Station Daaba, District Ludhiana, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985.

Short affidavit of Sh. Shamsher Singh Boparai, PPS, Superintendent, Central Jail, Ludhiana, has been filed in Court and the same is taken on record. According to this affidavit the petitioner is suffering from a kidney problem as well. There is continuous weight loss and the petitioner appears to be anorexic.

According to the FIR, 270 grams of psychotropic powder was recovered from the petitioner during a search conducted on 23.04.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is suffering from Hepatitis-C apart from HCV. The petitioner cannot get proper medical attention in the jail. Thus, he prays for interim bail for a period of three months.

The affidavit submitted on record on behalf of the State-respondent conclusively shows that the petitioner has a serious medical problem and deserves appropriate medical attention.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with direction that the petitioner-Baljinder Singh @ Bhumbli be released on interim bail for a period of three months from today to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned. He shall surrender before the trial Court on 04.01.2019.
