Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.147 dated 12.06.2018, registered under Sections 365 & 34 IPC at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana.

On the last date of hearing, the petitioner had given the phone number of Dharmender, who is said to have enticed the girl.

Copy of the order has been placed on record to show that the boy had converted and they had approached the High Court for direction.

The State counsel informs that the girl has been recovered and she is now lodged in Nari Niketan and she had refused her medical.

The petitioner is in custody since 12.06.2018. Recovery has been effected. The girl refused her medical.

The trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
