By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.599 dated 5.6.2017 registered under Sections 51, 52(A), 63 and 68-A of Copy Right Act, 1957 and Sections 506, 420 and 201 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Karnal City, District Karnal and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 24.7.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of petitioners/accused Gurmeet Singh, Ashish Mahajan, Rohan Mahajan and Davinder Kaur as well as of complainant Bharat Bhushan Kapoor have been

recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves. It has specifically been opined by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.599 dated 5.6.2017 registered under Sections 51, 52(A), 63 and 68-A of Copy Right Act, 1957 and Sections 506, 420 and 201 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Karnal City, District Karnal and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
