Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of FIR No.21 dated 09.02.2017 under Sections 341, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.4, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the order dated 18.09.2017 passed by the trial Court, vide which charge under Section 323, 341 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC was framed against the petitioner-accused, is revisable. He further states that though the charge was framed on 18.09.2017, but the prosecution evidence has yet not commenced. He seeks withdrawal of the present petition, however, with liberty to challenge the said order dated 18.09.2017 by filing a revision petition before the Court of Session.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

It is made clear that in case it is found that no witness has been examined on behalf of the prosecution, the revisionary Court shall not dismiss the revision petition solely on the ground of limitation.
