Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.181 dated 24.12.2017, registered under Section 382/454 IPC at Police Station C Division, District Amritsar City.

Petitioner was arrested on 27.12.2017 at a Naka installed by police party on the basis of secret information involving the petitioner in the occurrence which allegedly took place on 23.12.2017. Petitioner along with her brother was arrested and recoveries were effected from them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the

petitioner was not named in the FIR. Naming the petitioner by the special informer would be debatable as to the complicity of the petitioner after three days of the occurrence, whereas recoveries of alleged articles were effected from the petitioner as well as from her brother.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harnek Singh submits that all the accused have been arrested and the *challan* will be filed very soon. The investigation is almost complete. The petitioner is a lady.

At this stage, without adverting to the merits of the case, I am of the view that petitioner, who is in custody since 27.12.2017 can be enlarged on bail.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail, subject to her furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
