ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J.(ORAL)

Vide order dated 14.09.2016, the personal appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court was exempted while issuing notice of motion to the respondent.

Since the proceedings are going on before the trial Court, the counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition be disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously. The personal appearance granted to the petitioner shall remain operative subject to furnishing an undertaking before the trial Court that the petitioner shall be represented through his counsel; he shall not delay/stall the proceedings of the trial; he shall not dispute his identity as accused; he shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in his absence but in the presence of his counsel; he shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court and other condition which the trial Court may impose.

However, it will be open for the trial Court to recall the order granting exemption from personal appearance if petitioner fails to abide by the above terms and conditions and the petitioner will appear before the trial Court on any substantive date when his personal appearance is required.
