The petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.97 dated 12.06.2018, registered at Police Station Bhargo Camp, Police District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, under Sections 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (Section 482 IPC added later on).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that pursuant to order dated 25.07.2018, petitioners have joined the investigation and have been cooperating therewith. This is not disputed by the learned counsel for the State.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 25.07.2018, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 by them.
