This is the third petition for seeking regular bail in FIR No.435 dated 16.06.2016 under Sections 148/147/323/307/365/452 IPC and 25 of Arms Act, P.S. Sector 55, Faridabad.

The first application i.e. CRM-M-20606-2017 was dismissed as withdrawn by the petitioner on 18.08.2017. The second bail application i.e. CRM-M-4716-2018 was dismissed on merits vide order dated 18.05.2018 while observing as under:-

“In view of the fact that the name of the petitioner is specifically mentioned in the FIR and he fired a shot in the stomach of the complainant and took away his wife and the petitioner is also facing two murder cases in FIR No.28 of 2014 and FIR No.13 of 2014, considering the gravity of the allegations and the unscrupulous conduct of the petitioner, he is not entitled for grant of regular bail. Thus, the petition stands dismissed.”

In pursuance of the order dated 31.08.2018 passed by this Court, status report was filed by way of an affidavit dated 16.08.2018 of

Assistant Commissioner of Police, Mujesar, Faridabad and disclosed that there are five other criminal cases pending against the petitioner.

On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that there is no other case pending against the petitioner and the cases mentioned in the affidavit are factually incorrect.

Today, again a fresh affidavit dated 09.09.2018 has been filed by the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Mujesar, Faridabad and he has reiterated that following seven other criminal cases pending against the petitioner:-

1. FIR No.58 dated 24.04.2015 u/s 392, 394 IPC and 25/54/59 Arms Act PS Rozka Meo District Mewat.
2. FIR No.130/2015 u/s 392 IPC PS Kama, District Bhartpur Rajasthan.
3. FIR No.140/2015 u/s 399, 402, 307 IPC and 3/25 Arms Act P.S. Kama, District Bharatpur, Rajasthan.
4. FIR No.259/2015 u/s 3/25 Arms Act P.S. Barsana, District Mathura.
5. FIR No.260/15 u/s 41/102 Cr.P.C and 411/413 IPC PS Barsana.
6. FIR 464/15 u/s 379 IPC, P.S. Kama.
7. FIR No.13/2014 u/s 147, 148, 149, 323, 341, 324, 325, 307 and 302 IPC and 3/25-54-59 Arms Act, P.S Jurhera.

Since no changed circumstances have been brought to the notice of the Court by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, this Court finds no merit in the present petition and the same is dismissed.
