The petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail in FIR No. 65 dated 27.06.2017 under Sections 353/186/506/148/149 of the IPC (Sections 332/224/34 of the IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar, Rupnagar.

Learned State counsel has filed status report on behalf of the respondent. Perusal of the same shows that the efforts to arrest the petitioner were made but he remained absconding and now he has been declared as proclaimed offender on 24.07.2018.

In view of the later development and status report of the learned State counsel furnished today in Court, the present petitioner is not entitled to anticipatory bail.

The present petition is dismissed accordingly.
