GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 31 dated 06.05.2015 under Sections 324,323,34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), Police Station Lakho Ke Behram, District Ferozepur and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 25.7.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ferozepur has been received to the effect that statement of complainant Bava Singh and also of petitioners/accused Amarjit Singh, Manjit Singh and Sukhdev

Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have entered into a compromise. The complainant has specifically stated that he does not wish to pursue the case further. The learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ferozepur has specifically opined that the parties have entered into the compromise voluntarily, without there being any threat or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.31 dated 06.05.2015 under Sections 324, 323, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), Police Station Lakho Ke Behram, District Ferozepur and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
