The petitioner prays for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to safe guard his life and liberty and that of his family.

The case of the petitioner is that his minor daughter has been kidnapped by respondents No.4 and 5 and FIR No.0058, dated 10.07.2018 has been registered at Police Station Amritsar (Rural), under sections 363/366-A IPC. Respondent No.3 is pressurizing the petitioner to compromise the matter with the private respondents. He is also threatening the petitioner and his family. Representation dated 16.07.2018 (Annexure P-3) has been submitted before respondent No.2, but no action has been taken till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

Mr. Jasdeep Singh Walia, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Let four copies of the complete paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. Considering the nature of the order being passed,

there is no necessity to issue notice to respondents No.4 and 5.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2, to objectively consider the representation dated 16.07.2018 (Annexure P-3), within a period of four weeks' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and take appropriate action in accordance with law, in case it is found necessary. He is also directed that no harm is caused to the petitioner and his family.
