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**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner seeks necessary directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take necessary action against respondents No.4 to 10 who had allegedly trespassed into the house of the petitioner and had caused damage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in fact respondent No.8 had filed civil suit against the petitioner seeking permanent injunction which was dismissed and that despite dismissal of the same, respondents No.7 to 10 are bent upon causing damage and harm to the petitioner.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent

No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-4) expeditiously and in case, the allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest. It is further directed that in case, there is any genuine apprehension of threat to life and liberty of the petitioner, then adequate steps be taken so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioner.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-4) be sent to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
