The petitioner prays for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to expeditiously investigate the FIR No. 54 dated 27.04.2018 registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar under Sections 379-B, 341, 148, 149 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite representation dated 20.07.2018 (Annexure P-5), the police is not taking any interest in the investigation.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. J.S. Walia, Sr. DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice to the private respondents.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 3 to objectively consider the representation dated 20.07.2018 (Annexure P-5) and to conclude the investigation in the aforementioned FIR expeditiously.
