At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not wish to press the present petition and that he will take the plea available to him before the trial Court at the relevant stage and time.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty to take plea as aforesaid.

Counsel further submits that personal appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court may be exempted. However, it would not be appropriate to accept this request in the present proceedings.
