Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to complete the investigation in case FIR No.0002 dated 04.01.2017 under sections 420, 467, 468 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Samana District Patiala.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Bhinderpal, submits that during the investigation, one accused-Sukhdev Singh has been found to be innocent and proceedings to declare Lakhbir Singh Kambo @ Ramandeep Singh and Dalbir Singh proclaimed offender is pending before the trial Court. It is further submitted that the other accused, namely, Tarun Mulari and Karnail Singh were arrested and are on regular bail and Pargat

Singh son of Karnail Singh has been granted anticipatory bail.

As per affidavit filed by the Deputy Superintendent of Police,
Samana, District Patiala, the investigation is going on.

Learned State counsel submits that the report under Section 173
Cr.P.C. will be presented before the trial Court within a period of 3 months
from today.

under Section 173 Cr.P.C. before the trial Court within a period of three
months from today.
