This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 35 dated 19.08.2011, registered at Police Station-Lakhewali, District-Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Sections 279, 338, 427, IPC (charges framed under Sections 279, 337 and 338, IPC) as also for setting aside the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 20.01.2017 passed by the JMIC, Malout. The conviction is under Sections 279, 337 and 338, IPC and maximum sentence is RI for two years with fine of Rs.500/- and in default of payment of the fine to undergo further RI for fifteen days.

Pursuant to order dated 21.08.2017, report dated 16.09.2017, has been received, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been reached between the parties without any threat or coercion.

In view of above, FIR No.35 dated 19.08.2011, registered under Sections 279, 338, 427, IPC (charges framed under Sections 279, 337 and 338, IPC) at Police Station-Lakhewali, District-Sri Muktsar Sahib and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner. Appeal pending before the Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib is rendered infructuous.
