Petitioner Vikas alias Bholu has filed this petition seeking grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.95 dated 24.2.2018, under Sections 379-A, 412 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar, Sonapat.

As per FIR registered at the instance of Amit, on 22.2.2018 he had kept his licenced revolver .32 bore and one mobile phone in a drawer of wooden bed in his shop and had gone to a nearby shop for some work and when he returned back he found the same missing. In the aforesaid FIR no one was named as an accused.

During the course of investigation of the aforesaid FIR, complainant Amit came up with altogether different version to the effect that

on the intervening night of 21/22.2.2018 when he was going from his shop to his house, then he was waylaid by three boys who came on a motorcycle and one of them pointed a pistol at him and another snatched his licenced revolver and that previously due to fear he had made an incorrect statement.

The learned State counsel has informed that the challan has since been presented and that charges have also been framed. It has also been informed that the petitioner has been behind bars for the last 4 months.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and that the petitioner has been behind bars since the last about 4 months, in my opinion it is a fit case for grant of regular bail. The petition is as such accepted and petitioner-Vikas alias Bholu is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sonapat.

This petition stands accepted accordingly.
