The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Davinderpreet Singh in case FIR No.0030 dated 22.02.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 336, 506, 427, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Chheharta, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

Heard.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. He has been arraigned solely on the basis of supplementary statement of the complainant, wherein it has been stated that the petitioner was accompanying the attacking party. He is in custody since 22nd February, 2018. Chargesheet has already been presented.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of

trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
