Today, at the very outset Mr. Uday Chauhan, Advocate has put in appearance and filed power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.2/complainant, which is taken on record.

Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.173, dated 17.12.2013 under Sections 324, 323, 506, 498-A and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) and other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise effected amongst the parties vide order dated 26.04.2018.

The parties were directed to appear before the trial Court for getting their statements recorded. Report of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur has been received wherein it has been stated that pursuant to the order dated 26.04.2018, passed by this Court, statement of complainant-Balwinder Kaur as well as accused Gagandeep Singh has been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter by the intervention of the respectables.

The learned trial Court in its report has opined that the compromise arrived at between the parties appears to be genuine, voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion and with free will of the parties.

In view of the aforesaid position, this Court is satisfied that the matter has been resolved amicably. As such, the petition is hereby accepted and the FIR and all subsequent proceedings are ordered to be quashed.
