In the present petition, petitioner seek anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.102 dated 23.05.2013 under Sections 406, 379 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.5, Civil Lines, Ludhiana City.

2. This Court vide order dated 08.08.2018 had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial court and join proceedings and in the event of his appearance, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of trial court, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions of Investigating Officer states that in pursuance to the order dated 08.08.2018 petitioner has joined proceeding before the trial court and obtained order dated 10.08.2018.

4. In view of these factual aspect and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 08.08.2018,

granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. However, petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or other wise interfere with the fair trial.

6. Accordingly, petition stands allowed. However, trial court is at liberty to initiate proceeding under Section 446 Cr.P.C. for violation of bail bond against the petitioner and his surety.
