Petitioner Mehboob has filed this petition seeking grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.218 dated 3.4.2018, under Sections 323, 342, 379-B, 384, 506 and 511 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 147 and 149 were deleted and Section 34 IPC was added), registered at Police Station Sector 58, Faridabad.

The allegation, in nutshell, are that on the day of occurrence when the complainant was going on his motorcycle to meet his sister-in-law, then the present petitioner Mehboob along with Harun, Mubin, Hasam, Imran and 10/12 persons caught hold of him on the way and gave him kick and fist blows and locked him in a room with an intention to kill him and sprinkled petrol on him. It is alleged that he was kept in the said room from

3.30 PM to 8 PM and that the said accused snatched his mobile and cash amounting to ₹4200/-. It is alleged that he heard Mehboob talking to his wife demanding ransom of ₹1,50,000/-.

Notice of this petition was issued to the State. It has been informed by learned State counsel that the challan has since been presented in the present case and that the petitioner has been behind bars for the last 4 months.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and that the petitioner has been behind bars since the last about 4 months and that conclusion of trial is likely to take some time, in my opinion it is a fit case for grant of regular bail. The petition is as such accepted and petitioner-Mehboob is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Faridabad.

This petition stands accepted accordingly.
